For those who have missed the news, 2 changes were made at the Club banquet regarding club officers. There is a new treasurer, Jay Farrand, and a new secretary, Bob Brouillette. Please send all checks and monies to Jay, and any club correspondence to Bob.

Spring work weekend will be held on Saturday 05/14/2016. We ask you to bring tools for road work (i.e. brush snips, tractors, dump trailers) and gear for possible club cabin and new lodge repairs. Meals will be served at the main lodge. Breakfast (starting at 7am), lunch (Noon), and dinner (6pm) on Saturday and breakfast on Sun (8am). Please bring your own drinks for lunch and dinner.

The new 2016 gate combination will take effect Sunday 05/15/2016. Please contact Bob if you have paid your dues and did not receive your club card. Please be patient as we (Bob/Jay) transition to our new duties.

The 2016 annual membership dues are \$800. Full or partial (\$500) payment is due by May 14,2016. Cabin owner assessment (notice of this payment in January newsletter) of \$250 is due May 1st (although if your plan is to pay at work weekend that would be accepted). Regular cabin owner fee (taxes) is still \$150 and are due by August 15, 2016. Propane tanks are still \$100. Missed work weekends continue to be \$50 and guest fees \$10 (for any part of a day). All fees are due within 30 days from the date first incurred; a 10% per-month late fee will be owed to club thereafter. Al has also announced anyone wanting a 400# propane tank, the price for tank is \$400-\$425 and total for tank and fill approx. \$700-\$750. If anyone is interested in the **big** tank please notify Al.

Reminders:

Please, I know we keep announcing, but please, no parking is allowed on the state land between the lakes. Penalties for violations can range from \$100 to the loss of your membership. Members are responsible for all actions of their guests. Also, no motors are permitted on Lows Lake. All ATVs (must be insured and registered) and boats need to be registered. Helmets are required for all ATV riders. Remember to wear/use your PFDS while on the water.

2016 Club buttons will be available to paid members during spring work weekend, at the picnic, or at Bob B., Jay, or Bob M. camps. Sorry buttons cannot be mailed.

Annual Robinwood picnic will be held on July 30, 2016. Auction, great meal, and lots of fun, more details to follow.
