Picnic: The annual Robinwood picnic and meeting is planned for Saturday July 25, 2015. Please bring a side dish or dessert to pass, your own drinks, useable or unusual items for the auction, and a few dollars to spend. Dinner and music by Edison Kane begins at 1 PM, followed by our auction around 3 PM, and more music at 4 PM, and a club meeting around 5-6 PM. Edison Kane play 1960-1990s Rock & Roll. Check for other activities and for any changes in times for dinner, music, and auction at the front gate on July 24th-25th.

Fall work weekend will be held on Saturday September 12th, 2015.

Dues and fees: IF YOU HAVE NOT PAID YOUR DUES OR OTHER FEES OR UNDERPAID ANY, PLEASE FORWARD PAYMENTS TO BARRY BEFORE JULY 31st. The annual membership dues for 2015 are \$700; cabin taxes of \$150 are due by August 15th. Costs for propane tanks are \$100; Missed work weekends are \$50 and guest fees remain at \$10 or \$5 (winter). All fees are due within 30 days from the date first incurred; a 10% per-month late fee is owed to the club thereafter.

Firewood: The large piles of cherry, maple, and beech on Road 7 may be cut and used at cabins or camp sites on our lease. **DO NOT REMOVE THIS** (or any other) **FIREWOOD FROM THE CLUB.**

All NY State regulations apply to you and your guests while at Robinwood Park. Members are responsible for all actions of their guests. Any violations of state/club regulations can threaten your safety and everyone's access (and use) of club roads and lakes. All **ATVs and boats** need to be registered, helmets are required for all ATV riders, ATVs have to be licensed and insured, PFDs have to

be in your boat (and on children), except for short term (2-3 minute) loading & unloading, **PARKING IS NOT PERMITTED ON STATE LAND**, and no motors are permitted in your boat while on Lows Lake (beyond the Jeep Trail). To ensure a few people do not ruin the privileges we all enjoy, each member is asked to report any violators to the board. Penalties for violations can range from \$100 to loss of membership.

ALL MEMBERS AND GUESTS MUST SIGN THE LOGBOOK AT THE MAIN GATE. Any adult guest, who is on the lease and did not sign the logbook may be asked to vacate the property, and not be permitted to return. Any member who did not sign the logbook will be asked to return to the main gate and sign in.
