Costs for **propane tanks** are now \$100; Missed work weekends are \$40 and guest fees remain at \$10 or \$5 (winter). All fees are due within 30 days from the date first incurred; a 10% per-month late fee is owed to the club thereafter.

All violations on state land by members or their guests will incur a fine of up to \$700 or loss of membership.
