Annual Banquet: Robinwood's annual banquet and meeting will be held at the Old Post Grill, part of the Clarion Inn & Suites in Lake George, NY on April 11th, 2015. There will be cocktails and hors d'oeuvres from 6 - 7 PM; and dinner will be served at 7 PM. **If you plan to attend, please contact me and/or send \$30 per meal/attendee to me before March 30th, 2015.** A block of 15 rooms at \$89.99-129.99 are reserved for members of Robinwood; call (518) 793-3196 to make your room reservation.

Club roads: Please note that 4x4 trucks are permitted on the club roads only with chains or cables (on at least 2 wheels). **DO NOT TO PULL TRAILERS BEYOND THE GATE** on any day for any reason. Please leave all trailers (of any type) in the dirt parking lot before the gate, and well out of the traffic lane that the logging trucks will need at the lot.

Also keep your snowmobile or ATV speeds safe and reasonable and plan on a big truck blocking the road at every turn - just in case one is there. The steep and hard banks mean you cannot simply get up the bank and out of its way, so you often need to stop and turn around if the road is too narrow to pass.

Dues and fees: The annual **membership dues** for 2015 will be the same as last year (\$700), and are owed by May 15. **Cabin taxes** remain at \$150 and are due by August 15. Costs for **propane tanks** are \$100; Missed work weekends are \$40 and guest fees remain at \$10 or \$5 (winter). All fees

are due within 30 days from the date first incurred; a 10% per-month late fee is owed to the club thereafter.

Club events: The tentative date for spring work weekend is Saturday May 16th; the annual club picnic is Saturday July 25th; and Fall Work weekend is Saturday September 12th, 2015.

Buck pool: Jim Eldrid won \$150 for the heaviest deer (155 lbs) and Ken Balliet Jr. won \$50 in the random draw from the 8 deer and 3 bear entered onto the game sheet at the lodge.

ATVs, boats, parking, fishing and hunting: Please note that all ATVs and boats need to be registered, helmets are required for all ATV riders, ATVs have to be licensed and insured, PFDs have to be used while on the water, absolutely no parking is permitted on state land, and no motors are permitted in Lows Lake. All violations on state land by members or their guests will incur a fine of up to \$700 or loss of membership.
