Our Annual Club Banquet (April) will again fall victim to the current CO-VID virus crisis. Our club BOD's do not want a repeat of last Spring where we tried to schedule, then had to cancel after members had sent in meal \$\$ and made hotel reservations. We wish to thank our members for paying all \$\$ owed by years end and for members who donated extra \$\$ along with countless hours rendered on the clubs behalf. All early payments are certainly appreciated.

unofficial (no gathering) work bee on the weekend of 5/15, similar to what we did this past year.

We have tentative dates for the remainder of our normal club functions: **Picnic** 8/14, **Fall WW** 9/11&12, and **opening day dinner** 10/23.
