Hello All,

Well Spring keeps teasing us with some very nice weather, then WHAM, winter comes back with a vengeance. On Tuesday April 19th the club and surrounding areas received approx. 8-12 inches of heavy wet snow, bringing down A LOT of small trees and branches throughout the club. This weather event will now delay the opening of the main club road by at least another week. We had hoped to possibly open the road sometime during the last week of this month. We are now hoping for some time the first week of May. Water will be turned on at the cooks lodge and house lodge this coming weekend. Please stay tuned for road opening date.

A normal "Full-On" spring work weekend (SWW) will be held May 14 &15 with Saturday breakfast (7am), lunch (noon), dinner (6pm), and breakfast again at 8am Sunday morning. PLEASE RSVP to me by May 11th if you plan on attending. We will continue brushing back spur roads that need it plus sections of the main road. We will also be re-supplying the two club camps with wood. Please bring brush nips, chainsaws, and gloves. Rock picking off the roads from raking will also need to be done. We hope to possibly have some of the road repairs/culverts done before the actual work weekend.

The new 2022 club/gate combination will take effect on Sunday May 15th. Please contact me if you have paid your dues and do not receive your card at SWW or have not been notified that it awaits for you to pick up in the club mailbox at Bob B's camp. We like to watch our postage costs, but if you do wish for your card to be mailed, that certainly can be done. Club buttons will also be made available at club functions and in the mailbox at Bob's camp. We also have the club 50th

anniversary t-shirts currently at Bob B.'s camp for pickup. We will make every effort to make sure each paid member receives their t-shirt. We also have a limited supply for sale at a cost of \$20. Other items available include a 50th club anniversary pub style glass.

The 2022 membership dues are \$800. Full or partial (\$500) payment is due by May 1ST. If paying in installments, your second payment is due by August 1ST. If you wish to pay at SWW, that is always acceptable. Cabin taxes are due by August 15TH. Permanent camper/site fee is \$100 and is due upon picking your site and a one-time receipt of camper/trailer/site guidelines form. Propane tanks are \$100, Missed work weekend continue to be \$50 and guest fees are \$10 (for any part of the day), winter fee is \$5 per day. ALL fees are due within 30 days from the date first incurred. A 10 % per month late fee will be owed the club thereafter. If you are making an initial dues payment after May 15th then that will be considered late unless you have made prior arrangements.

REMINDERS: All ATV's need to be registered / insured, UTV's need to be insured, boats need to be registered. Helmets are required for ALL ATV riders. PFD's should be used while out on the water. Absolutely no parking is allowed on the state land between the lakes (penalties can range from \$250 fine to loss of membership) and no motors are permitted on Lows Lake. Club family picnic will be held on Aug. 6th. Fall work weekend will be Sept. 10/11. Boys Scout lease packets will be available at SWW. A signed Hold harmless form is required upon pick up of your packet. If you need this form (haven't turned one in yet) please let Bob M. or myself know that you need one. Member packets not picked up will be left with your name on them in the Cooks lodge as long as we have received your hold harmless form.
