Hello All, Spring has sprung finally! We hope all current Robinwood members renew their memberships for 2017/2018. Our annual club banquet and meeting held in Lake George was attended by 49 members, spouses and friends. Spring work weekend will be held on May 20 & 21. Work we hope to accomplish: House Lodge, painting, repair window screens, repair woodshed floor, cleaning. Fix portion of roads #7 and 10. Annual permanent **CAMPER** site fee is \$100 and is due upon picking your site and receipt of Camper/Trailer guidelines paper(signed) to Jay Farrand.

PROPANE tanks are still \$100.

MISSED work weekends continue to be \$50 and **GUEST** fees \$10 (for any part of a day). All fees are due within 30 days from the date first incurred. A 10% per-month late fee will be owed to club thereafter.

REMINDERS: No parking allowed on the State land between the lakes.

Penalties for violations can range from \$100 to the loss of your membership. Members are responsible for all actions of their guests. No motors are permitted on Lows Lake. All ATV's must be insured and registered. Boats need to be registered. Helmets are required for all ATV riders. Wear/use your PFDS.
